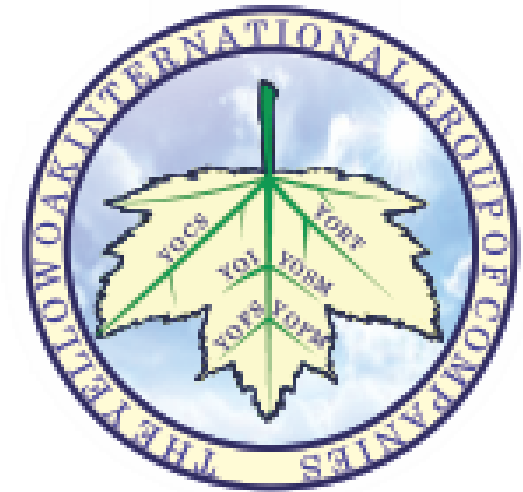

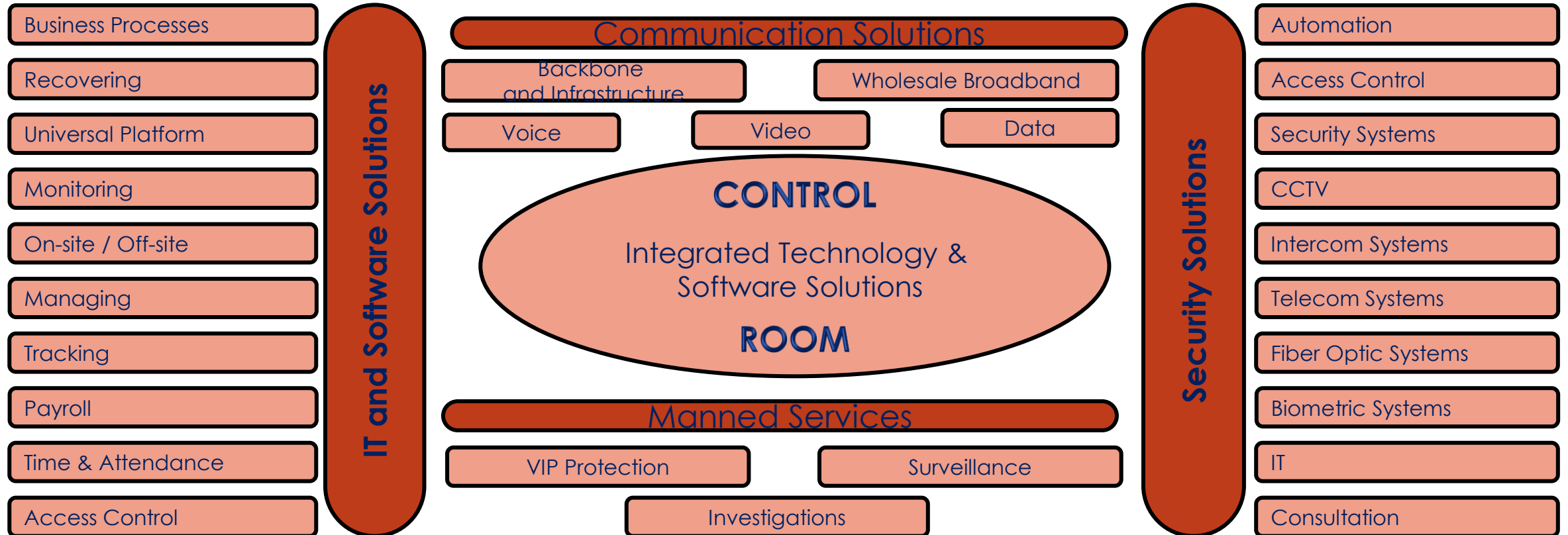

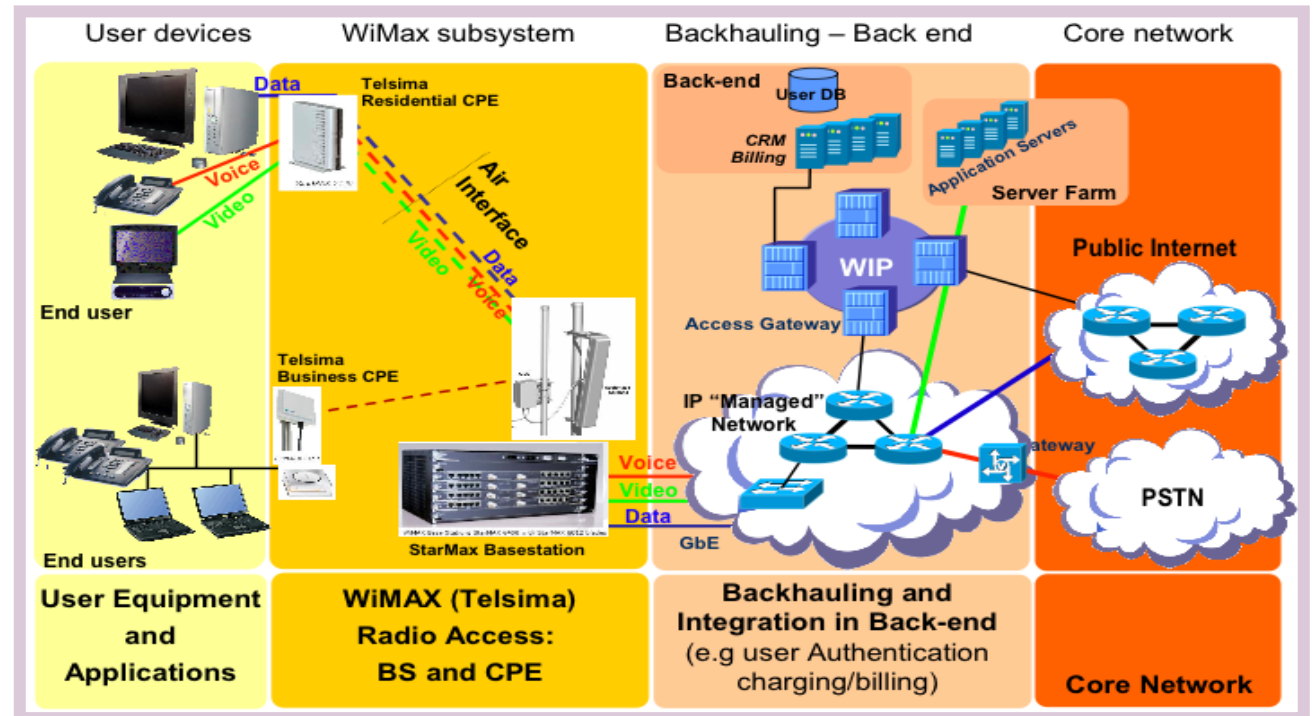

Communications Infrastructures

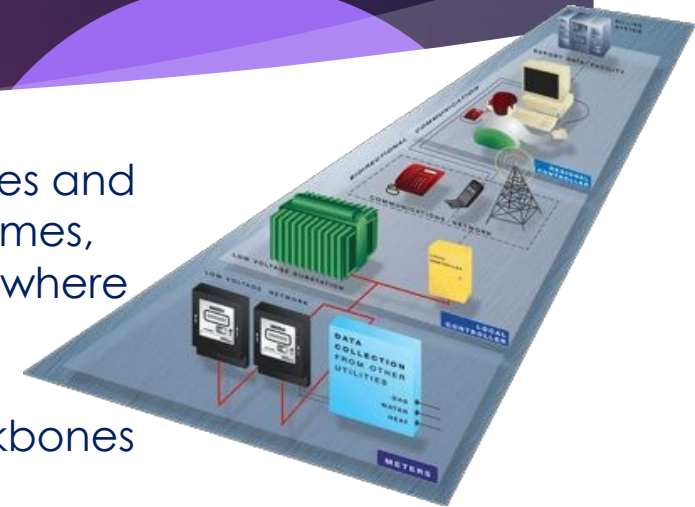
